- Grant in Aid snowmobile trails to Wykoff, Preston, Ostrander and Spring Valley

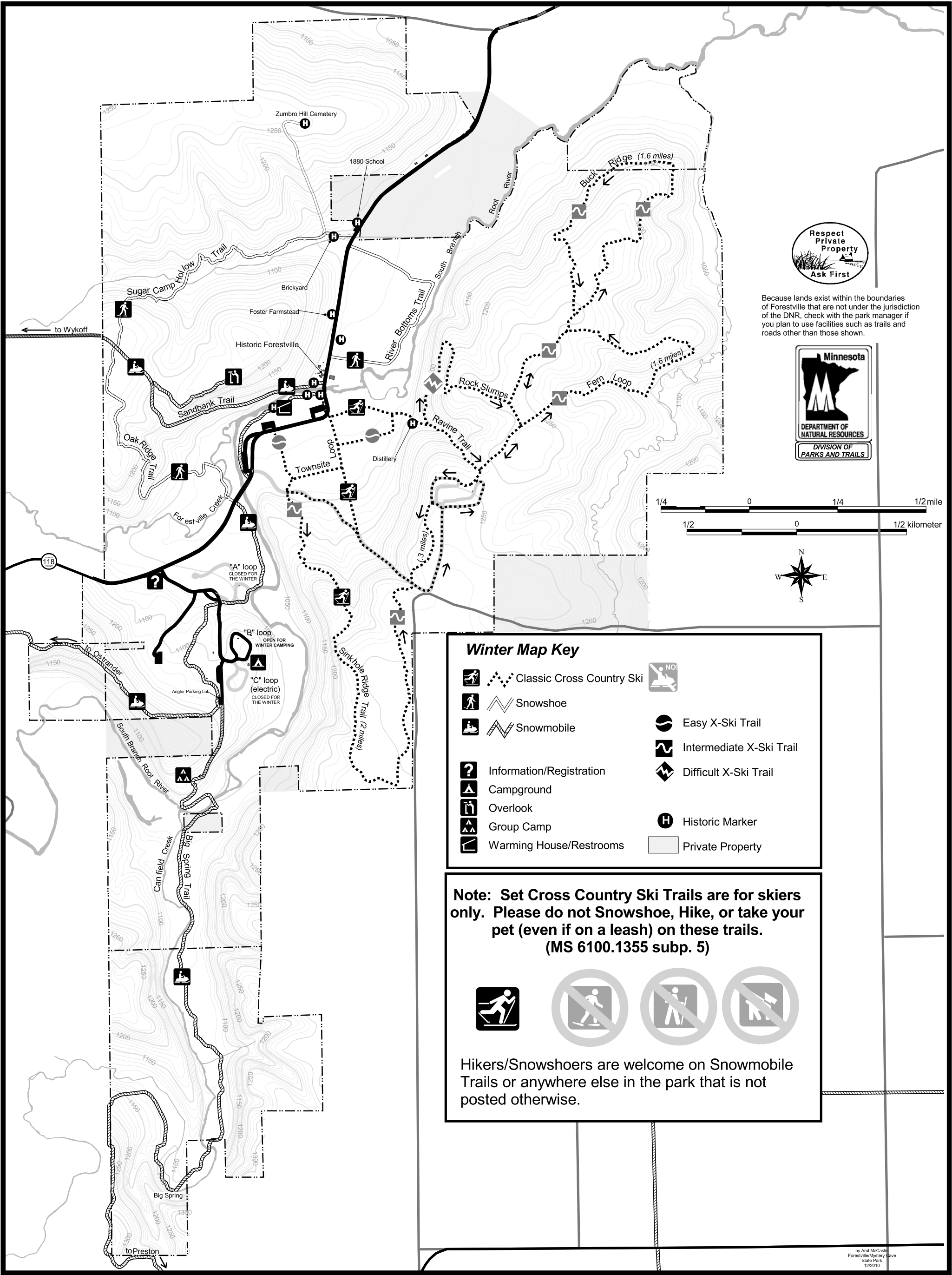
Visitor Favorites:

- Historic markers throughout the park

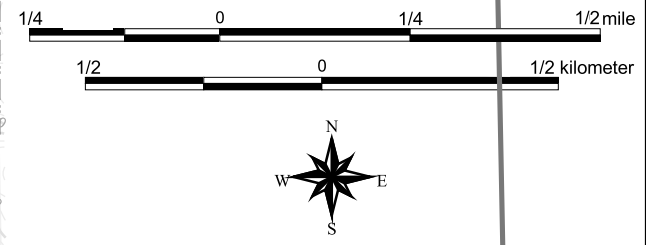
Looking for more information?
